

Part Two – Classroom Information



- **Parent Volunteers:** You are more than welcome to volunteer and chaperone in the classroom. Before you can do so, you need to fill out a district Clearance Form in the Office; you will also need to have a T.B. Test done. Once you've been cleared, please let me know prior to your arrival when you'd like to come. This way, we can plan for you to help in a constructive manner. Constant unscheduled visits can be disruptive to the room. Although, if it is a unique situation where you have a chance to stop by, feel free to come in.
- **Student Materials:** All school supplies have been provided for use in the classroom. Any supplies you purchase for your child would be best used at home for homework and projects.
- **Students Toys:** Toys are not allowed at school. Any item that is disruptive will be taken away and returned when the parent signs and returns the note sent home to notify of the disruption.
- **Snacks:** As our custom, we will ask that each child in our class take a turn providing a snack for the class. A snack calendar will go home each month. Please make sure your treat is store bought and enough for 22 students. I encourage the snacks to be healthy ones (refer to the District's healthy snack guidelines). Any fruit must be whole. If you choose to send something that will need to be divided, i.e. Cheerios, crackers etc. it would be greatly appreciated if you would send something to divide them into, such as little cups, or baggies.
